

The VN-INDEX rose 0.3% on Consumer Staples, Materials, Industrials large caps despite profit taking

The VN-INDEX added 0.3% in extending its gain to the third consecutive session as Consumer Staples, Materials and Industrials sectors advanced, while the HNX-INDEX fell 0.8%, snapping the eight-day gaining streak. Vietnam's main stock market opened with optimistic sentiment and the index quickly rose to its intraday peak of 888.4pts (+1.1%). SAB (+5.2%) and VNM (+1.4%) were the largest supporters, adding a combined 2.5pts to the index. The stocks were joined by other large caps, such as HPG (+1.0%), BID (+1.0%), CTG (+2.4%) and BVH. Market pillars from the Aviation sector also performed well, including VJC (+2.4%) and HVN (+4.3%). However, profit taking emerged in the afternoon and dominated other large caps, thus narrowing the index's gain. The selling appeared at the start of the holiday-shortened trading week, following the market's two straight gains. Vietnam's stock market will close on 2 Sep to mark the National Day and trade will resume on Thursday. Today's bearish large caps included VCB (-0.5%), TCB (-1.4%) and GVR (-1.7%). Finally, the VN-INDEX edged up 0.3% to close at 881.7pts, the highest since its 10 Jun close of 900.7pts. In Hanoi, the HNX-INDEX fell 0.8% to end at 124.9pts, its first fall in nine sessions.

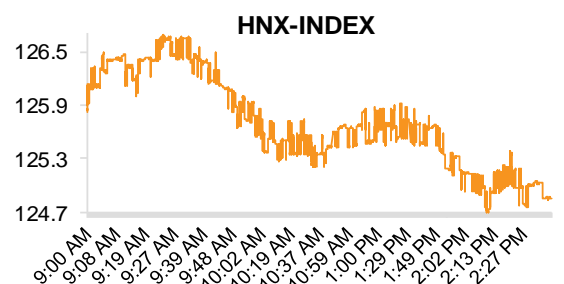
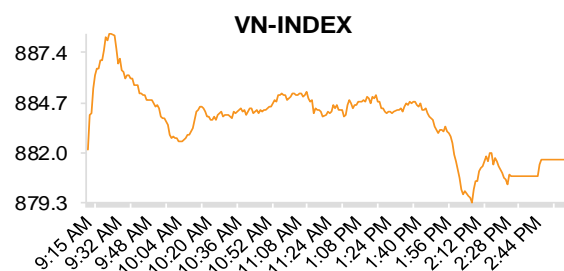
Consumer Staples (+1.8%), Materials (+0.5%), and Energy (+0.5%) rose, while IT (-0.9%), Health Care (-0.5%), and Utilities (-0.3%) lost ground today. Top index movers included SAB (+5.2%), VNM (+1.4%), CTG (+2.4%), BID (+1.0%) and HVN (+4.3%). Top index laggards consisted of VCB (-0.5%), TCB (-1.4%), GVR (-1.7%), LGC (-6.9%), and VPB (-1.1%). Top three major put-through transactions were TPB with 3.3m shares (VND70.6bn), VHM with 0.9m shares (VND67.7bn), and VPB with 2.8m shares (VND63bn).

Foreigners net sold on HOSE to the amount of VND287.0bn, and also net sold on HNX to the amount of VND18.8bn. They mainly bought PLX (VND120.8bn), VNM (VND78.8bn) and VHM (VND52.3bn); and mainly sold VHM (VND153.5bn), VNM (VND71.3bn) and VRE (VND64.2bn).

Market News

Oil climbs above US\$43 with demand back in focus after storm fades

Oil rose above US\$43/barrel in New York with focus returning to the fragile demand recovery after the hurricane threat eased. Futures added 0.8% in New York amid a broader rally in equities, snapping a two-day decline. Chinese economic activity continued to rebound in August as the world's second-largest economy emerges from the virus slump. Meanwhile, U.S. Gulf Coast refineries started the recovery process after Hurricane Laura passed, with facilities in southeast Texas avoided the worst of the storm. Oil is poised for a fourth monthly advance but prices are firmly anchored near US\$43/barrel and struggling to push further as nations across the globe battle to contain the virus. The market is also contending with more supply from OPEC+ after the group started easing its historic output cuts, while signs emerged that Chinese crude purchases are starting to slow. *(Bloomberg)*

Pig imports push domestic pork prices down in Vietnam

Efficient reproduction of pigs and enhancing imports of frozen pork and live pigs have made prices of live hogs fall, according to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD). The ministry forecasts that pork supply will increase from the end of the third quarter, leading to stability in pork prices on the domestic market, according to the ministry's report on pork supply sent to the Government. The report says so far, Vietnam has licensed companies from 24 countries to export pork and poultry meat products to Vietnam.

In 7M20, Vietnam imported more than 93,248 tonnes of pork, mainly from Canada, Germany, Poland, Brazil, the US, Spain and Russia, up 223% yoy. The ministry licensed imports of live pigs from Thailand to Vietnam for slaughter for food from June 12. Deputy Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development Phung Duc Tien also said Việt Nam did not set a quota for imports of live pigs and pork while the Department of Animal Health always created favourable conditions for customs clearance of pork imports. However, importing pork had been difficult as African swine fever had reduced the global pig output by 12%. Over the past week, live hog prices nationwide gradually decreased each day. According to the MARD, the production cost at present is VND71,000/kilo of live hog if breeders buy piglets for production and VND50,000/kilo if they build a chain from piglet production to pig production. By the end of July, pigs for slaughter reached 4.87m head, up 17% year-on-year. The domestic husbandry industry expects to produce 5.17m pigs by the end of 3Q20 and 5.36m in 4Q20, up 68% compared to the volume at the beginning of this year. *(Vietnamnet.vn)*

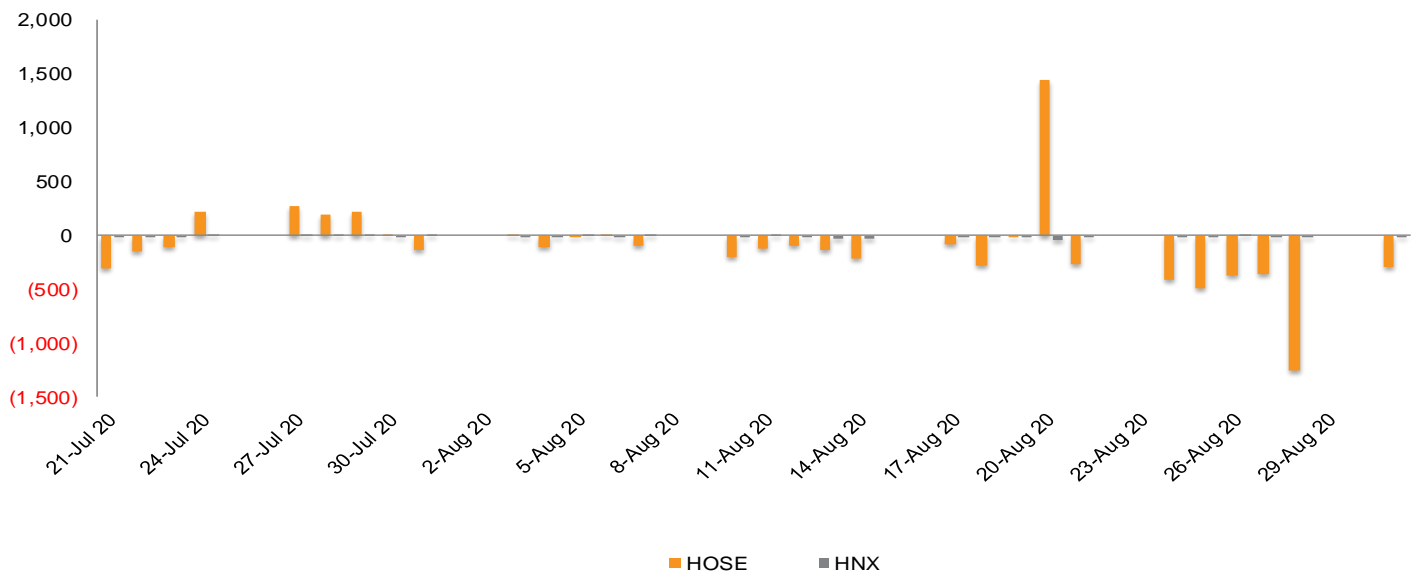
