

Market commentary: The VN-INDEX hit 6-week high as BID and CTG lent strong support

The VN-INDEX rose 0.9% to its six-week high at close, extending gains to the second consecutive session with support from Financials large caps including BID and CTG. Vietnam's main stock index opened bullishly as investors increased appetite for banking large caps, especially BID and CTG. Specifically, BID jumped 3.3% to VND51,300 and alone added 1.9pts to the index's gain, following by CTG (+4.9%) and VCB (+0.9%). The upward momentum further escalated in the afternoon session as blue chips from Real Estate and Consumer Staples sectors joined the rally, led by SAB (+2.9%) and VHM (+1.4%). On another note, some blue chips faced strong selling pressure and suffered losses, including PLX (-0.9%), MSN (-0.9%) and ROS (-6.9%). However, these laggards were far surpassed by the bullish large caps. The VN-INDEX thus gained 8.4pts (+0.9%) to land at 968.5pts, the highest level since 29 Nov, 2019 when it hit 970.8pts, and the HNX-INDEX also ended up at 102.2pts (+1.0%).


Financials (+2.1%), Consumer Staples (+0.8%) and Utilities (+0.6%) rose while Energy (-0.9%), Health Care (-0.6%) and IT (-0.1%) dropped. Top index movers included BID (+3.3%), SAB (+2.9%), CTG (+4.9%), VHM (+1.4%) and VCB (+0.9%). Top index laggards consisted of PLX (-0.9%), MSN (-0.9%), ROS (-6.9%), PGD (-6.9%) and BHN (-1.3%). Top three major put-through transactions were NTC with 0.9m shares (VND144.9bn), TBD with 2.0m shares (VND116.4bn) and AMV with 2.3m shares (VND55.5bn).

Foreigners net bought on HOSE to the amount of VND1,072.8bn, while net sold on HNX to the amount of VND1.8bn. They mainly bought PGD (VND1,020.8bn), VHM (VND141.5bn) and VNM (VND96.2bn); and mainly sold VHM (VND132.2bn), VCB (VND89.2bn) and VNM (VND74.7bn).

Market News

Oil set for first weekly loss since November on receding risk. Oil headed for its first weekly loss since November as fears over a U.S.-Iranian war receded, easing concern of a potential supply disruption in the Middle East. Futures fell 0.3% in New York and are down almost 6% so far this week. The U.S. House of Representatives voted Thursday to limit President Donald Trump's authority to strike Iran, while America received indications that the Islamic Republic has asked militias in the Middle East not to carry out attacks against U.S. interests, Vice President Mike Pence said in comments to Fox News. *(Bloomberg)*

World Bank maintains Vietnam's GDP growth forecast at 6.5% in 2020. The World Bank has maintained Vietnam's GDP growth forecast at 6.5% in 2020, unchanged from its previous prediction last June, according to the bank's latest report titled "2020 Global Economic Prospect." In 2020, the country's domestic demand is set to benefit from generally supportive financial conditions amid low inflation and robust capital flows. World Bank's forecast is in line with that of HSBC as it expected the economy to expand 6.6% year-on-year, putting Vietnam among fastest growing economies in East Asia and Pacific. HSBC stated as FDI inflows continues to add production capacity, Vietnam's manufacturing sector is likely to remain robust. On November 11, the National Assembly approved Vietnam's socio-economic development plan for 2020, including the GDP growth target of 6.8%. Vietnam's GDP growth in 2019 achieved an impressive pace of 7.02%, far exceeding the target set by the National Assembly at 6.6-6.8%. This marked the second consecutive year that Vietnam's economy expands over 7%, following a 10-year high GDP growth of 7.08% in 2018. According to the World Bank's report, global economic growth is forecast to edge up to 2.5% in 2020 as investment and trade gradually recover from last year's significant weakness but downward risks persist. Growth among advanced economies as a group is anticipated to slip to 1.4% in 2020 in part due to continued softness in manufacturing. Growth in emerging market and developing economies is expected to accelerate this year to 4.1%. This rebound is not broad-based; instead, it assumes improved performance of a small group of large economies, some of which are emerging from a period of substantial weakness. About a third of emerging market and developing economies are projected to decelerate this year due to weaker-than-expected exports and investment. In the East Asia and Pacific, regional growth is projected to ease to 5.7% in 2020, reflecting a further moderate slowdown in China to 5.9% this year amid continued domestic and external headwinds, including the lingering impact of trade tensions. *(Vietnamnet.vn)*

Vietnam Rubber Group - JSC (GVR VN HOSE) – 2020 targets: GVR has targeted revenue this year to reach VND29,933bn (+0.4% yoy) and a pre-tax profit of VND5,785bn (+12.7% yoy), the group said in a report. GVR has won permission to list 4bn shares on the Ho Chi Minh Stock Exchange and will become the second-largest company in terms of registered capital after BIDV. *(Ndh.vn)*


