

Market commentary: The VN-INDEX posted biggest loss since Oct 2018 as concerns over coronavirus mount

The VN-INDEX plunged 3.2%, the largest drop in over 14 months amid growing concerns over a novel coronavirus which could disrupt business operations. The VN-INDEX began the first trading session after a long holiday and immediately lost 16.4pts as investors became cautious about the negative effects of the virus on economic activities. Later, the index further dropped to its intraday trough at 954.0pts (-3.8%). A huge selling pressure emerged in Financials and Consumers Staples sectors. Specifically, banking stocks VCB and BID fell 4.8% and 5.1%, respectively, thus wiping out a combined 8.1pts off the index. Consumers Staples' large caps such as SAB and VNM dropped 6.2% and 3.9%, respectively. On the other hand, some defensive stocks from Health Care and Utilities sectors attracted huge buying demand and landed in the green, including DHG (+5.7%), NT2 (+3.9%) and DBD (+1.0%). However, these advancers were far surpassed by the bearish large caps. As a result, the VN-INDEX lost 3.2%, the biggest fall since 11 Oct, 2018 when it lost 4.8%, to close at 959.6pts, a three-week low, and the HNX-INDEX also dropped 2.0% to end at 104.1pts.

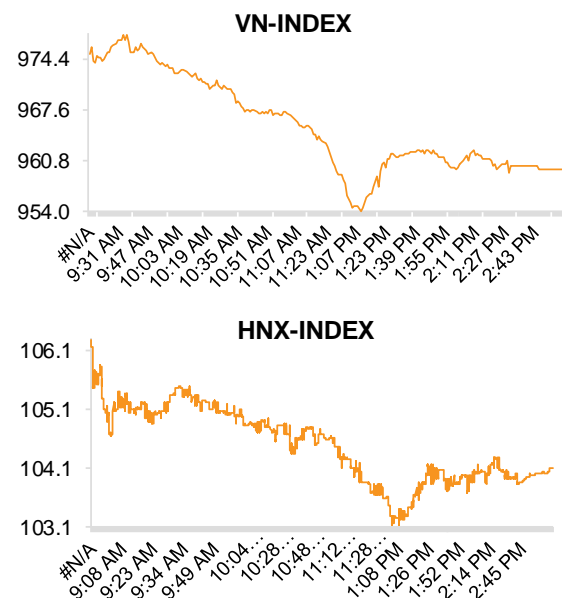
Health Care (+2.9%) rose while Financials (-4.6%), Consumer Staples (-4.4%) and Consumer Discretionary (-3.6%) dropped. Top index movers included DHG (+5.7%), EIB (+2.9%), VCF (+6.6%), NT2 (+3.9%) and VPD (+6.8%). Top index laggards consisted of VCB (-4.8%), BID (-5.1%), SAB (-6.2%), VNM (-3.9%) and VHM (-2.2%). Top three major put-through transactions were VNM with 2.0m shares (VND248.5bn), VEA with 1.3m shares (VND51.2bn) and NVL with 0.8m shares (VND45.4bn).

Foreigners net sold on HOSE to the amount of VND165.4bn, and also net sold on HNX to the amount of VND5.0bn. They mainly bought VNM (VND162.7bn), VCB (VND161.4bn) and HPG (VND104.7bn); and mainly sold VNM (VND241.4bn), VCB (VND194.9bn) and VHM (VND79.5bn).

Market News

Oil Declines After Biggest U.S. Crude Build Since November. Oil slumped as U.S. crude inventories rose by the most since November, raising concerns about oversupply. Futures fell 0.3% in New York on Wednesday. The Energy Information Administration reported that American crude stockpiles rose by 3.55 million barrels, more than analysts anticipated. Gasoline supplies reached a record high. The builds overshadowed growing tensions in the Middle East after an attack on Saudi Aramco's Jazan plant by Yemen's Houthi rebels sparked a brief price rally. *(Bloomberg)*

CPI in January hits 7-year high. Vietnam's consumer price index (CPI) in January rose 1.23 percent from the previous month and 6.43 percent year on year, according to the General Statistics Office (GSO). This is the highest January CPI growth recorded in the last seven years. Compared to the previous month, an upturn was seen in the prices of 10 out of 11 main groups of goods and services, leading by food and catering services (2.29 percent). It was followed by housing and construction materials (1.47 percent); goods and other services (0.92 percent); transport (0.69 percent); drinking and tobacco (0.65 percent); garment and textile, headwear and footwear (0.33 percent); household equipment and products (0.27 percent); and culture, entertainment and travel (0.25 percent). The only group experiencing price fall was post and telecommunications (0.03 percent). Do Thi Ngoc, head of the GSO's Price Statistics Department, explained that the CPI in January saw a strong rise due to the higher demand for food and foodstuff, drinks and textiles for the Lunar New Year (Tet) festival. The petrol and oil prices in January averagely increased by 1.29 percent compared to December 2019. Meanwhile, the price of gas in the month climbed 14.08 percent against the previous month. At the same time, domestic gold price was up 4.37 percent over the previous month; while that of U.S. dollar has been kept stable, at around 23,222 VND/USD. GSO said the core inflation in January, which is CPI excluding grain food, fresh foodstuff, energy and the State-managed medical and educational services, increased by 0.76 percent from December 2019, and 3.25 percent compared to the same period last year. The general inflation in January showed a faster pace than the core inflation, reflecting that price changes were mainly driven by higher prices of food, services, and petrol. *(Vietnamnet.vn)*

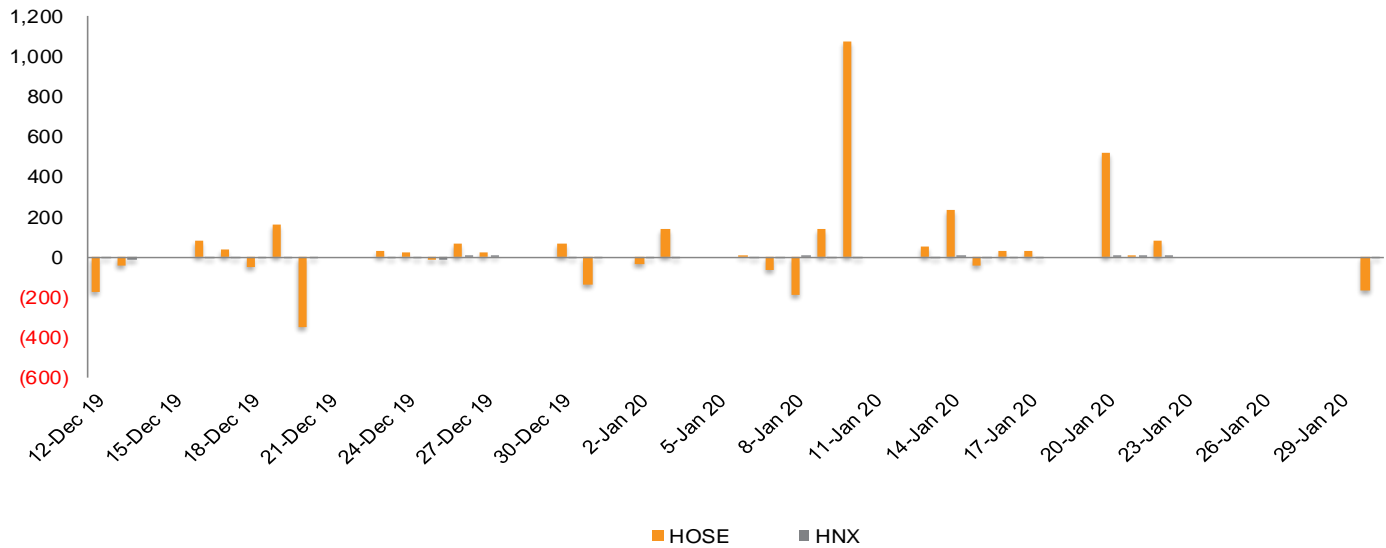
