

Market Commentary: The VN-INDEX edged down as Financials and Consumer Staples large caps tumbled

The VN-INDEX lost 0.1% to end at 918.8pts, as investors sold Consumer Staples and Financials large caps to take profit, despite some support from the Materials sector. The U.S. stock market had a brighter outlook after President Trump appeared to soften his stance on a further stimulus package for American households, airlines and small businesses. In Vietnam, after the slight gain at the start of the morning session, the VN-INDEX stood nearly flat, with some support from the Materials sector. Notably, GVR and HPG gained 3.9% and 1.1%, respectively, adding a combined 0.8pts to the index. MSN became the market's largest contributor, jumping 3.2% to VND63,900 and alone adding 0.7pts to the index's movement. But in the afternoon, the VN-INDEX fell to its intraday low of 913.9pts due to profit taking. VNM (-1.0%) and SAB (-1.1%) from the Consumer Staples sector became the largest laggards, eroding the index by 1pts. Several Financials stocks also lost ground, led by TCB (-2.1%), VCB (-0.2%), VPB (-1.3%), and EIB (-1.7%). Finally, the VN-INDEX edged down 0.1% to end at 918.8pts, while the HNX-INDEX dropped 0.4% to 135.6pts.

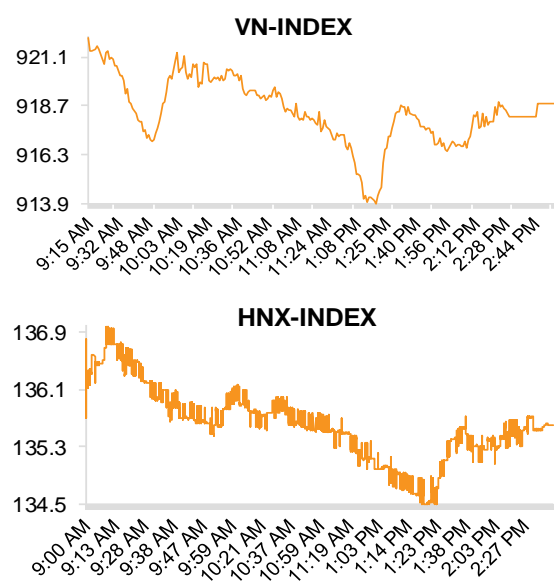
Consumer Discretionary (+1.3%), IT (+1.2%), and Materials (+0.7%) rose, while Financials (-0.4%), Real Estate (-0.3%), and Consumer Staples (-0.3%) lost ground today. Top index movers included MSN (+3.2%), GVR (+3.9%), HPG (+1.1%), GAS (+0.7%), and MWG (+1.8%). Top index laggards consisted of VNM (-1.0%), TCB (-2.1%), SAB (-1.1%), VCB (-0.2%), and VPB (-1.3%). Top three major put-through transactions were PNJ with 1.3m shares (VND84.9bn), HPG with 2.3m shares (VND63.7bn) and TCB with 2m shares (VND47.3bn).

Foreigners net sold on HOSE to the amount of VND98.4bn, and also net sold on HNX to the amount of VND1.2bn. They mainly bought HPG (VND162.3bn), PNJ (VND84.9bn), and VNM (VND60.7bn); and mainly sold VNM (VND101.9bn), HPG (VND101.6bn), and PNJ (VND84.9bn).

Oil gains near US\$40 with hurricane delta threatening gulf output

Oil rose near US\$40/barrel in New York with the market turning its attention to a hurricane that's caused widespread shut-ins to Gulf of Mexico output. Energy operators in the Gulf of Mexico have shut 80% of oil output in preparation for Hurricane Delta, which barreled across the Yucatan Peninsula and is poised to hit the Louisiana coast on Friday. Stock markets also edged higher on Thursday on hopes that American lawmakers will reach a stimulus deal. *(Bloomberg)*

Vietnam issues action plan to implement National Energy Development Strategy

Vietnam aims to raise its renewable energy sources to 15-20% of the total energy supply by 2030 and 25-30 cent by 2045. The targets have been set in the Government's action plan on the implementation of Vietnam's national energy development strategy by 2030. PM Nguyen Xuan Phuc has issued the action plan to realise the Party Central Committee's Resolution No. 55-NQ/TW dated February 11, 2020 on the orientation of the National Energy Development Strategy to 2030. Under the action plan, the Government will strive to meet domestic energy demand and satisfy targets of the 10-year socio-economic development strategy for 2021-2030. Specifically, total primary energy supply will reach 175-195m tons of oil equivalent (TOE) by 2030 and 320-350m TOE by 2045. Total installed capacity of power sources will be raised to about 125-130 GW and the power output to 550-600bn kWh by 2030. Total final energy consumption will touch 105-115m TOE by 2030 and 160-190m TOE by 2045. Primary energy intensity will be 420-460 kgOE/US\$1,000 GDP by 2030 and 375-410 kgOE/US\$1,000 GDP by 2045. The ratio of energy saving over total final energy consumption compared to the business-as-usual scenario will be increased to around 7% by 2030 and 14% by 2045.

The Government targets to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from energy activities against the business-as-usual scenario by 15% and 20% by 2030 and 2045, respectively. It also plans to build a smart grid system that can be connected safely with regional grids and meet N-1 criteria for important load centres and N-2 criteria for extremely important load centres. The reliability of power supply will be among the top four ASEAN countries while the power access indicator among the top three ASEAN countries over the next decade. By 2045, the Government will synchronously develop factors of a competitive and transparent energy market in accordance with the socialist-oriented market economy; ensure sustainable development of energy sub-sectors as well as efficient utilisation of natural resources. The Government will also focus on ensuring the quality of human resources, technological and scientific qualification and governance capacity of the energy sector to meet the level of a modern and developed country. In order to fulfill these targets, the plan sets key tasks, including developing primary energy supply sources towards increasing self-sufficiency, diversification, ensuring efficiency and sustainability; rapidly and sustainably developing the electricity sector to meet the country's modernisation and industrialisation demand; and restructuring sectors and regions consuming power in parallel with implementing policies on using clean energy and using energy economically and effectively. Other tasks include restructuring, renewing and improving operation efficiency of State-owned enterprises in the field of energy; encouraging the private sector to develop energy; and renewing mechanisms and policies and developing the energy market comprehensively and effectively. *(Vietnamnet.vn)*

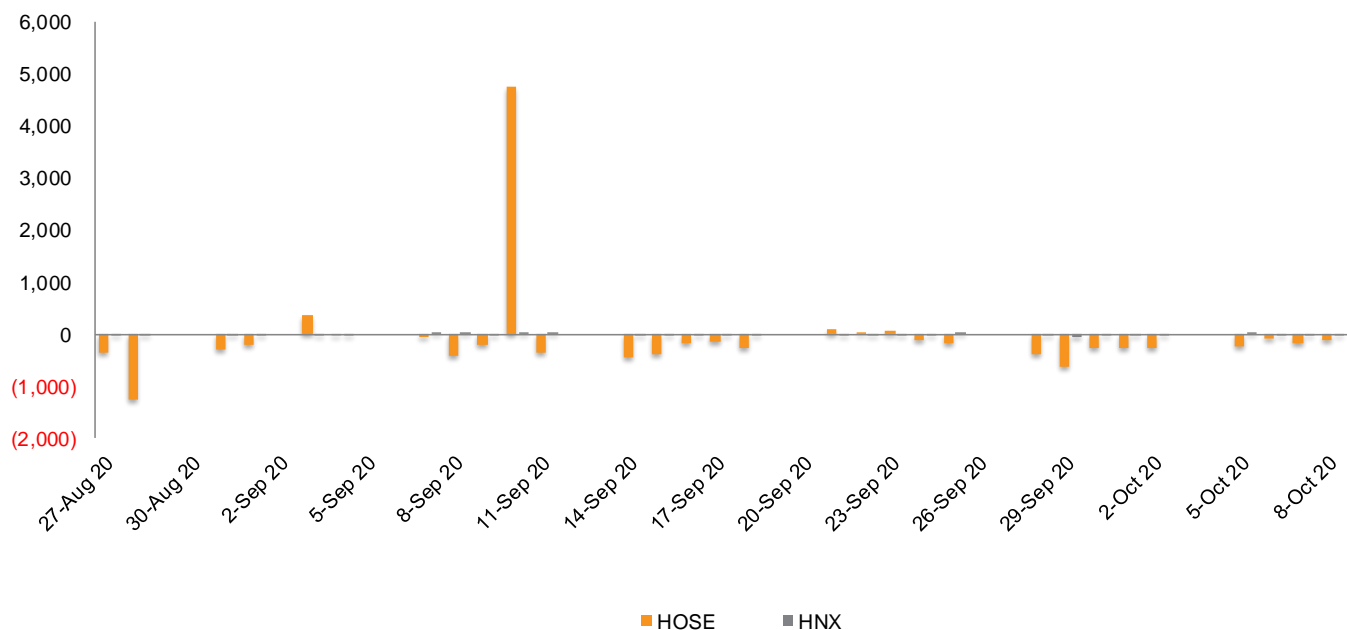
