

Market commentary

After four consecutive days of gains, correction returned and caused Vietnam Stock Markets to sink in red. Following the opening's retreat, VN-INDEX slipped lower and only reversed slightly near the midday break. In the afternoon, the index still struggled to regain lost ground as selling pressure persistently dominated the market. Despite the positive trend in oil prices, Energy and Utilities sectors experienced sluggish trading, of which PLX and GAS were among the three largest laggards impeding the market's recovery. At the same time, Financial stocks, including BID, CTG, VCB, STB, MBB and BVH, pulled back sharply, thus further exacerbating the investors' pessimism. Even worse, Real Estate sector also recorded dramatic losses, driven by VIC that was sold aggressively by foreigners and QCG that bottomed at the floor price. Consequently, VN-INDEX shed 3.34pts (-0.43%) to end at 775.54pts with 115 gainers, 148 laggards and 69 unchanged. Meanwhile, HNX-INDEX hovered around its reference level for the whole day before safely landing at 100.48pts (+0.15%) with 104 winners, 95 losers and 178 unchanged.

Many sectors declined, led by Health Care (-0.99%), Financials (-0.97%), and Real Estate (-0.65%) while Information Technology (+0.47%), Consumer Discretionary (+0.41%), and Materials (+0.36%) rose. Regarding tickers, top index laggards included PLX (-1.74%), BID (-1.93%), GAS (-1.01%), CTG (-1.45%), and VIC (-0.71%). Top index movers were SAB (+0.43%), HT1 (+5.18%), TLG (+6.47%), KDC (+2.47%), and ITA (+6.93%). Top 3 highlighted block trades consisted of ITA with 16.8mn shares (VND67.3bn), GEX with 2.75mn shares (VND53.2bn), and SHS with 2.9mn shares (VND45.8bn).

Foreigners net bought on both exchanges with total net-buying value of VND28.7bn. They mainly bought HPG (VND35.5bn), VNM (VND31.9bn), and KDC (VND23.5bn) while sold VIC (VND32.9bn), VNM (VND32.5bn), and SSI (VND25.4bn).





Market News

Oil snapped its longest run of gains this year as OPEC output rose amid a boost from members exempt from supply cuts. Futures slid 0.5% in New York after advancing almost 11% the previous eight sessions. OPEC production in June climbed to the highest level this year because of increases from Libya and Nigeria, which aren't bound by the group's accord to cut, according to data compiled by Bloomberg. U.S. crude inventories probably dropped by 2.5mn barrels last week, a Bloomberg survey showed before a government report on Thursday. (Bloomberg)

Ministry of Finance (MOF) rejects LG Display's plan to increase investment capital by US\$90mn to US\$1.59bn in concern of possible financial imbalance if foreign-invested enterprises rely heavily on loans. According to MOF, the documents submitted by LG Display to ask for permission did not explain where the capital would come from. LG Display's documents showed that the company's contributed capital to the project remains unchanged at US\$100mn. If the investment capital is raised to US\$1.59bn, the capital contribution from LG Display would account for only 6.29% of total investment capital. (English.vietnamnet.vn)

Vietnamese banks expect 2017 profit growth at about 13%. About 91% of Vietnamese banks expect credit growth to be 5.09% in Q3 and 16.33% at end-2017, according to survey conducted by the Central Bank's Monetary Forecast and Statistics Department. Banks forecast 3Q deposit growth at 4.72% and 16.02% at end-2017. Besides, banks expect liquidity at stable level in Q3 and bad debt ratio at banks to reduce in the period. (Bloomberg)

Vietnam's foreign reserves rose by US\$1bn in 1H2017 to record high of US\$42bn, according to State Bank Governor Le Minh Hung. Besides, Mr. Hung said Vietnam will manage dong exchange rates as Federal Reserve Bank may increase rates. (Bloomberg)

Corporate News

Sai Gon Thuong Tin Commercial Joint Stock Bank (STB VN) - FY2015-2016 AGM resolution: According to the FY2015-2016 AGM resolution, STB sets 2017 business targets of VND585bn in EBT (vs. VND155.6bn in 2016's). Total assets by end-2017 is expected at VND384.6trl (+15.8% YoY) while total customers deposits and customers credits are targeted at VND356.1trl (+16.8% YoY) and VND277trl (+16.4% YoY), respectively. Besides, Mr. Duong Cong Minh, who is the Chairman of Him Lam Corporation, was voted to replace Mr. Kieu Huu Dung as STB's Chairman for 2017-2021 term while Mr. Dung was approved to become the bank's Vice Chairman for the same term. Additionally, BoD member Pham Van Phong was also appointed as the new Vice Chairman from Jun 30 while Deputy CEO Nguyen Duc Thach Diem was assigned as new CEO, replacing Mr. Phan Huy Khang from Jul 03. (Hsx.vn)

Vietnam National Chemical Corporation (Vinachem - Unlisted) - business activity: Vinachem has asked government for US\$125mn debt at Ninh Binh Fertilizer Plant, according to Ministry of Finance. The corporation borrowed US\$250mn from China Eximbank and the current outstanding loan was at US\$162.5mn as of end-March. (Bloomberg)



Hoa Sen Group (HSG VN) - business activities: HSG has decided to establish two new branches named Hoa Sen Group Corporation - Thuan Chau - Son La Branch and Hoa Sen Group Corporation - Yen Thuy – Hoa Binh Branch. (Hsx.vn)

VIETJET Aviation JSC (VJC VN) - **key personnel changes:** VJC announced to dismiss Ms. Noraesyah Yvonne Binti Abdullah from CFO cum information disclosure representative position from Jul 01. Besides, Vice CEO Tran Hoai Nam was appointed as the new CFO and COO Luu Duc Khanh was selected as the new information disclosure representative from Jul 01. (*Hsx.vn*)

Coteccons Construction JSC (CTD VN) - **key personnel changes:** CTD's BoD approved the appointment of Mr. Nguyen Ba Duong as the new Chairman following his resignation from the CEO position, knowing that the CEO position would be filled by Mr. Nguyen Sy Cong. Besides, the BoD also approved the resignation of Mr. Tran Quang Tuan as CTD's Vice CEO as well as the BoD member of Unicons Corporation - CTD's wholly owned subsidiary. (Hsx.vn)

Khanh Hoi Investment and Service Corporation (KHA VN) – key personnel change: KHA' BoD approved the appointment of Deputy Head of Finance – Accounting Department Tran Thai Phong as the new CFO starting Jul 01. (Hsx.vn)

Bibica JSC (BBC VN) - **tender offer:** PAN Food JSC announced the public bidding of 1,121,670 BBC shares (7.27%) with the price of VND112,800/share from Jul 06 to Aug 21. If successful, PAN Food will raise its stake in BBC to 7,864,600 shares (51%). (*Hsx.vn*)

Thien Nam Trading Import Export JSC (TNA VN) – 1H2017 consolidated business results and share issuances: In 6M2017, TNA generated VND2.108trl in gross revenue (+25.6% YoY), which accounted for 66% of the year plan. TNA also recorded VND73.7bn in EBT (+9.6% YoY), completing 70.2% of whole-year target. For further information, TNA issued 1,999,399 bonus shares for current shareholders and 487,991 ESOP shares. (Hsx.vn)

Bao Viet Securities Company (BVS VN) – 2017 AGM Resolution: According to AGM resolution, BVS' shareholders approved 2017 business plan with VND324bn in total revenue (+10.1% YoY) and VND102bn in EAT (+0.3% YoY). Shareholders also approved the issuance of 36.1mn BVS shares to existing shareholders at the ratio of 2:1 with the price of VND10,000/share in order to raise the company's chartered capital within 2H2017. Besides, the company decided not to pay 2016 dividend but planned to pay 2017 dividend at the ratio of 7% (not stated in cash or stock). (Cafef.vn)

Masan Consumer Corporation (MCH VN – UPCOM) – share issuance: MCH will issue about 5mn ESOP shares (0.96%) at the price of VND10,000/share from Jul 04 to Jul 11, equivalent to the total value of VND49.7bn. (*Cafef.vn*)

Agribank Securities JSC (AGR VN) – 2017 business plan: AGR's shareholders approved the bank's 2017 business plan of VND141bn in total revenue (+5.5% YoY), VND69bn in EBT (vs. the loss of VND365.8bn in 2016's) as well as the restructuring plan during 2016 – 2018 period. (*Cafef.vn*)

Thien Viet Securities JSC (TVS VN) – dividend payment: Jul 14 and Jul 17 will be the ex-date and record date, respectively, for receiving 2016 cash dividend of VND600/share (est. 2016 dividend yield of 5.1%), 2016 stock dividend at the ratio of 100:7 and bonus shares at the ratio of 100:2. The cash dividend payment will be made from Jul 28. (Cafef.vn)



An Duong Thao Dien Real Estate Trade JSC (HAR VN) – business activity: HAR's BoD has approved to buy 100% stake of Coral Island Resort JSC. After the transaction, Coral Island will become HAR's subsidiary. (Cafef.vn)

Petrolimex Joint Stock Tanker Company (PJT VN) – **shareholder's activity:** Mr. Phan Van Cau successfully sold 250,000 PJT shares from Jun 28 to Jul 03, thus reducing his stake to 778,210 PJT shares (5.07%). Additionally, on Jul 03, Mr. Phan Van Ky bought 250,000 PJT shares to raise his ownership to 775,120 shares (5.04%), thus becoming the company's major shareholder. *(Cafef.vn)*

Hoang Huy Investment Financial Services JSC (TCH VN) – **dividend payment:** Jul 11 and Jul 12 will be the ex-date and record date, correspondingly, for receiving 2016 cash dividend of VND800/share (est. 2016 dividend yield of 4.2%). The payment will be made from Aug 15. (*Cafef.vn*)

Truong Long Engineering and JSC (HTL VN) – dividend payment: Jul 07 and Jul 10 will be the exdate and record date, correspondingly, for receiving the second 2016 cash dividend of VND1,500/share (est. 2016 dividend yield of 9.5%). The payment date will be from Jul 20. (*Cafef.vn*)

Tien Giang Investment and Construction JSC (THG VN) – shareholder's activity: BoD member cum CEO Tran Hoan Huan purchased 84,450 THG shares, which is beyond 70,000 THG shares registered from Jun 14 to Jun 30, due to an error in the order execution. Accordingly, Mr. Huan raised his stake from 267,914 shares (2.23%) to 352,364 THG shares (2.94%). (Hsx.vn)

Duyen Hai Multi Modal Transport JSC (TCO VN) – **shareholder's activity:** For personal financial purpose, BoD member Dao Kim Phuong has registered to buy 100,000 TCO shares from Jul 05 to Jul 28 via order-matching or put-through method, knowing that she currently owns 431,450 TCO shares (2.31%). (Cafef.vn)

Real Estate 11 JSC (D11 VN) – **dividend payment:** Jul 13 and Jul 14 will be the ex-date and record date, respectively, for receiving the remaining 2015 cash dividend of VND400/share. The payment date will be Aug 03. (*Cafef.vn*)


