

Market commentary

Despites the wild fluctuations during the trading day, both indices of Vietnam Stock Markets still managed to close in green with improved liquidity. Following the positive start, increased selling pressure dragged VN-INDEX down to the intraday low of 714.27pts. However, thanks to many bullish large caps, VN-INDEX gradually recovered. In particular, ROS continued its winning streak and contributed largely to the market with 0.86pts. CII, DHG, and FLC advanced noticeably and were among the top market movers. On the other hand, VJC corrected for the first time after 5-day rally and was the index's main laggard reducing by 3.57%. The downward trend existed in many heavy-weighted F&B tickers, including VNM, SAB, and BHN. Besides, Banking sector mixed today as VCB was the second largest supporter while STB, CTG, BID, and EIB headed down. Even though struggling a little bit in the afternoon, VN-INDEX extended the gains by 0.03% to 716.54pts with 129 gainers, 112 losers, and 82 unchanged. HNX-INDEX experienced choppy trading but managed to bounce back and ended the day at 86.7pts (+0.17%) with 84 advancers, 84 decliners, and 212 unchanged.

Most sectors advanced, led by Health Care (+3.50%), Energy (+1.34%), and Industrials (+0.92%). Consumer Staples (-0.64%), Information Technology (-0.21%), and Financials (-0.13%) negatively impacted the index. Regarding tickers, top index movers included ROS (+2.88%), VCB (+0.54%), CII (+6.86%), DHG (+5.74%), and FLC (+6.91%). Top index laggards were VJC (-3.57%), VNM (-0.69%), SAB (-0.85%), BHN (-3.37%), and STB (-2.78%). On the put-through market, top 3 major deals showed SBT with 5mn shares (VND112.5bn), VNM with 592,540 shares (VND77.1bn), and NLG with 3.2mn shares (VND73.6bn).

Foreigners net sold on both exchanges with total net-selling value of VND120bn. They mainly sold VNM (VND109.4bn), NLG (VND73.9bn), and VJC (VND61.2bn) while bought VNM (VND107.3bn), VJC (VND34.7bn), and MSN (VND17.8bn).

Market News

Oil traded near US\$53 a barrel as Iraq said it was ready to cut production in the second half of the year if OPEC decides to extend a policy limiting output to balance a global oversupply. Futures in New York were little changed after Iraq's oil minister said OPEC will probably need to extend its cuts beyond the first half, while Angola signaled willingness to prolong the deal as long as necessary. As the reductions in supply boost prices, oil companies are reviving investment following a two-year rout, the International Energy Agency said. (Bloomberg)

Vietnam's logistics sector aims to contribute 8-10% to gross domestic product (GDP) by 2025, heard a conference hosted by the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT) in Hanoi on Mar 06. MoIT Deputy Minister Tran Quoc Khanh said the plan to improve the sector's competitiveness till 2025 also aims to achieve 15-20% services growth and an outsourcing ratio of 50-60%, reduce costs by 16-20% of GDP and have the sector rank 50th or better globally in terms of national competitiveness. To hit these targets, Khanh suggested attracting investment in logistics infrastructure, including building logistics centres on regional and global scales to improve connectivity between Vietnam and countries worldwide. Vietnam Diary Products JSC (VNM VN) - **shareholder's activity:** F&N Dairy Investments PTE. LTD., which relates to BoD member Lee Meng Tat, bought 4,109,710 VNM shares via order-matching and put-through methods from Feb 06 to Mar 07, increasing its stake from 214,685,623 shares (14.79%) to 218,795,333 shares (15.07%). After that, the organization has continued to register to buy 21,771,420 VNM shares via order-matching and put-through methods from Mar 10 to Apr 07. If successful, it will increase its stake to 240,566,753 shares (16.57%). (*Hsx.vn*)

NBB Investment Corporation (NBB VN) - **shareholder's activity:** On Mar 03, Grinling International Limited purchased more than 445,000 NBB shares, increasing its stake from 557,000 shares (0.87%) to 1,002,000 shares (1.57%). Thus, the stake of the group of related shareholders increased from 8.79% to 9.49% (6,060,053 shares). Previously, on Feb 21, Grinling International Limited also bought 130,000 NBB shares (0.2%). Hoang Quan Consulting Trading Service Real Estate Corporation (HQC VN) - investment plan: People's Committee of Tra Vinh City has approved HQC's detailed plan regarding the Social Housing project (HQC Tra Vinh) in Ward 4, Tra Vinh City. The 18-ha project with total investment value of VND655bn is expected to start in 2Q2017 and be handed over to buyers from 4Q2018. (Cafef.vn)

Saigon Beer - Alcohol - Beverage Corporation (SAB VN) - 2017 AGM: Mar 16 and Mar 17 will be the ex-date and record date, correspondingly, for attending SAB's 2017 AGM. The meeting is expected on Apr 18. Further information will be announced later. (Vietstock.vn)

Sacom Development and Investment Corporation (SAM VN) - shareholder's activity: Vice Chairman Do Van Trac sold 9,059,507 SAM shares (5.026%) from Feb 06 to Mar 07 via order-matching and put-through methods, thereby reducing his stake to only 960 shares. (Cafef.vn)



Danang Chemical Industries JSC (DCI - unlisted) - stock listing: On Mar 08, 2,412,518 DCI shares will be listed on UPCOM with the reference price on the first trading date of VND63,000/share. For further information, DCI's chartered capital is over VND24.1bn. As of 25 Nov 2016, Vietnam National Chemical Group was DCI's largest shareholder owning 37.31% stake. (*Cafef.vn*)

Petrovietnam Oil Corporation (PV Oil - unlisted) - IPO: PV Oil, an unit of state-owned Vietnam Oil & Gas Group or PetroVietnam, is expected to undergo IPO by Jun 30 and sell 35%-40% of its shares to one or two strategic investors, aiming to raise at least US\$270mn, according to Chairman cum CEO Cao Hoai Duong. About 10 potential strategic investors, including "major oil companies" from Japan, South Korea, Thailand, Vietnam and the Middle East, have applied to buy the shares, he said. For further information, PV Oil will submit a short list of 5-6 potential strategic investors to Ministry of Industry and Trade this month. At the same time, only 10%-15% of the shares will be offered to public in the IPO. The company plans to use the money raised from the strategic investors and IPO for M&As to expand its market share beyond the current 22%-35%. Besides, PV Oil, which is currently valued at US\$460mn, will also consider overseas listing in the future. (Bloomberg)

CNG Viet Nam JSC (CNG VN) – dividend payment: CNG's BoD has approved to pay 2016 cash dividend of VND3,000/share. The payment will be made within 2Q2017. (*Ndh.vn*)

International Development and Investment Corporation (IDI VN) - FOL lifting: The IDI's BoD has submitted document to the State Securities Commission (SSC) and Ho Chi Minh Stock Exchange (HOSE) to seek approval for lifting its FOL to 100%. For further information, IDI's chartered capital stands at nearly VND1.816trl. (Ndh.vn)

Ben Tre Pharmaceutical JSC (DBT VN) – **dividend payment and 2017 AGM:** Mar 21 and Mar 22 will be the ex-date and record date, correspondingly, for receiving 2016 cash dividend of VND1,000/share (est. 2016 dividend yield of 5.9%) and participating in DBT's 2017 AGM. S.P.M Corporation (SPM VN) - **dividend payment and shareholder's activity**: Tomorrow will be the record date for receiving the first 2016 cash dividend of VND2,000/share. Such installment will be paid on Mar 20. Besides, Ms. Dao Thi Ngoc Anh - sister of Chairman Dao Huu Hoang - had registered to fully divest her entire holding of 383,580 SPM shares via order-matching and putthrough methods from Mar 01 to Jun 30. 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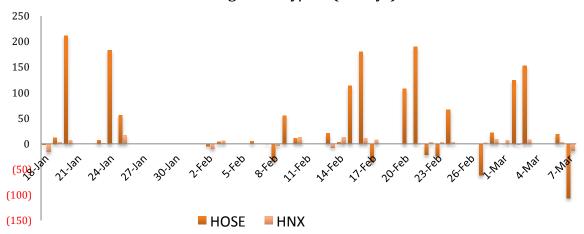
