

## **Market commentary**

Vietnam Stock Markets began the new trading week with broad advances as two indices jointly edged up to record noticeable gains. From the beginning, VN-INDEX gave out positive signals and spread excitement widely all over the market. In the afternoon, the index's rally was extended greatly and solidly maintained until the day-end closing. The market's upsurge was partly thanks to the buoyant Food & Beverages tickers, led by VNM, MSN and SBT. Notably, today's biggest spotlight belonged to Energy and Utilities sectors, of which PLX and GAS were boosted vigorously by foreigners' accumulation despite the unfavorable oil prices. Moreover, the investors' sentiment was further uplifted by the increases in leading Financial stocks, including CTG, MBB, BID, VCB, BVH and SSI. In contrast, huge loss was recorded by the worst performer ROS when this ticker tumbled to the floor price for a fourth consecutive day. Ending the session, VN-INDEX successfully conquered the 765-point resistance level to set a fresh multiple-year high of 766.83pts (+0.73%) with 157 winners, 119 losers and 54 unchanged. Similarly, the market's optimism was also widespread on the northern bourse and thus firmly supported HNX-INDEX to land at 99.41pts (+1.12%) with 110 advancers, 89 decliners and 178 unchanged.

Most sectors increased, led by Energy (+2.02%), Utilities (+1.37%), and Financials (+1.27%). Meanwhile, only Health Care (-1.33%), Industrials (-0.63%), and Materials (-0.29%) slumped. Top index movers included VNM (+0.92%), PLX (+2.24%), MSN (+3.07%), GAS (+1.22%), and CTG (+1.47%). Top index laggards were ROS (-6.91%), HPG (-1.13%), HNG (-3.76%), DHG (-1.94%), and TRA (-2.4%). Top 3 block trades showed NVL with 2.3mn shares (VND158.9bn), SAM with 3.5mn shares (VND37.5bn) and VNM with 180,000 shares (VND27.7bn).

Foreigners net bought on HOSE with net-buying value of VND111bn and net sold on HNX with net-selling value of VND17.2bn. They mainly bought VNM (VND107.1bn), ROS (VND44bn), and GAS (VND35.3bn) while sold VNM (VND97.8bn), NLG (VND39.1bn), and HPG (VND35.5bn).

### **Market News**

Oil traded near US\$45/barrel following a fourth weekly loss as U.S. drillers continued to add rigs, blunting OPEC-led efforts to rebalance an oversupplied market. Futures were little changed in New York after capping the longest run of weekly declines since Aug 2015. U.S. drillers targeting crude added rigs for a 22nd straight week, the longest stretch in three decades, according to data Friday from Baker Hughes Inc. Demand will rise during Q3, saying United Arab Emirates Energy Minister Suhail Mohammed Al Mazrouei. (Bloomberg)

Vietnam's PM Nguyen Xuan Phuc orders Transport Minister to seek advice from foreign companies on Tan Son Nhat International Airport expansion plan after public concerns over a golf course project near airport's runway. (Bloomberg)

Vietnam Ministry of Transport orders provinces and cities to suspend the issuing of new licenses for drivers under ride-hailing pilot programs such as Uber and Grab. Order follows proposals by Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City due to the pressure ride-hailing cabs put on traffic and traditional cabs. (Bloomberg)

## **Corporate News**

**NoVaLand Investment Group Corporation (NVL VN)** – **share issuance:** NVL plans to issue 33,459,554 shares in 2Q2017 to convert its debts at Credit Suisse AG (Singapore branch) at the price of VND40,867/share, which is equivalent to the conversion ratio of 4.0867:1. The shares will be subject to 1-year transfer restriction. Following the deal, NVL's chartered capital will increase from VND5.962trl to VND6.297trl. For further information, Credit Suisse's Singapore branch will assign 2 Vietnamese to take NVL new shares. (*Hsx.vn & Bloomberg*)

**Mobile World Investment Corporation (MWG VN)** – business activity: Jun 28 and Jun 29 will be the ex-date and record date, respectively, for seeking shareholders' written approvals of the new budget for M&A project in 2017. The implementation period will be from Jul 05 to Jul 15. (Vietstock.vn)

Gemadept Corporation (GMD VN) - private placement: On Jun 16, GMD received the approval from State Securities Commission (SSC) regarding the private placement to covert its loans. Accordingly, the company will privately issue a total of 108.8mn shares, including 87.6mn shares (30.41%) to Vietnam Investments Fund and 21.2mn shares (7.34%) to Ms. Le Thuy Huong, at the conversion price of VND10,640/share. These shares are subject to 1-year transfer restriction. Moreover, Vietnam Investments Fund and Ms. Huong will not be allowed to sell these shares directly on the market daily but can find strategic investors to transfer the shares. (Hsx.vn)

Hoa Binh Construction Group JSC (HBC VN) - shareholder's activity: Mrs. Do Thi Thanh Huyen - wife of Vice CEO Nguyen Van An - sold 12,950 HBC shares out of 12,955 shares owned (0.013%) from May 17 to Jun 14. (Hsx.vn)

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**Bien Hoa Sugar JSC (BHS VN)** - **shareholder's activity:** Vice CEO Nguyen Thanh Khiem has registered to sell 100,000 BHS shares via order-matching or put-through method from Jun 22 to Jul 21. If successful, his stake will be decreased from 240,120 shares (0.08%) to 140,120 shares (0.047%). (*Cafef.vn*)

**NBB Investment Corporation (NBB VN)** - shareholder's activity: Mrs. Duong Thi Ngoc Uyen - wife of Supervisory Board member Nguyen Van Tung - fully divested her stake of 140,950 NBB shares from May 15 to Jun 15. (*Vietstock.vn*)

**PetroVietnam Gas JSC (GAS VN) - dividend payment:** Jun 28 and Jun 29 will be the ex-date and record date, respectively, for paying the third 2016 cash dividend of VND1,000/share (est. 2016 dividend yield of 6.9%). The payment date will be Jul 24. (*Vsd.vn*)

**Vietnam Technological and Commercial JSB (TCB - unlisted) - 1Q2017 business results & stock buyback:** In 1Q2017, TCB's EAT rose 122% YoY to VND1.06trl. Besides, TCB plans to seek shareholders' approval to buy back 221.9mn outstanding shares, or 25% stake, in public tender offer this year. The bank offers to buy back shares at the minimum price of VND23,445/share. Notably, TCB plans to issue 500mn shares in order to raise its chartered capital to VND14trl. (*Bloomberg*)

Vietnam National Coal - Mineral Industries Holding Corporation Ltd. (Vinacomin - unlisted) - stock cutdown: PM Nguyen Xuan Phuc asks Vinacomin to focus on cutting down coal stocks. Coal inventory was at 9.3mn tons through June vs. 12mn tons at end-2016. Besides, 1H2017 coal consumption is seen to rise 2% YoY to 18mn tons (equivalent to 50% of full-year target). (Bloomberg)

**PetroVietnam Power Corporation (PV Power - unlisted) - IPO plan:** PV Power plans to hold IPO at end-October, citing information from the company. For more information, the corporation will offer 45% stake to major investors and may raise US\$600mn from IPO. Moreover, PV Power has met with investors from US, Hong Kong and Japan. (*Bloomberg*)

Masan Consumer Corporation (MCH VN – UPCOM) – 2017 EGM: MCH will hold its 2017 EGM on Jun 23 to seek for shareholders' approval to add one more BoD member for the term 2014-2019. The EGM will take place at InterContinential Asiana Sai Gon, 39 Le Duan Str., Ben Nghe Ward, District 1, HCMC. Besides, MCH dismissed Mr. Nguyen Hoang Tung from the Interim CFO position and appointed Vice CEO Pham Dinh Toai in replacement on Jun 06. (Vietstock.vn)

**PJICO Insurance Corporation (PGI VN)** – **business activity:** PGI has approved the plan to use the proceeds from its previous private placement of VND532.3bn. Accordingly, PGI will add VND80bn to its working capital, spend more than VND152bn on expanding network and developing information technology & financial investment system, and VND300bn on building the company's headquarter in Hanoi. (*Vietstock.vn*)

**Seafood JSC No.4 (TS4 VN)** – **shareholder's activity:** BoD member Nguyen Thi Ngoc Anh bought 613,000 TS4 shares from May 17 to Jun 15, thus lifting her ownership from 179,100 shares (1.12%) to 792,100 shares (4.94%). (*Cafef.vn*)

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Materials Transport Cement JSC (VTV VN) – dividend payment: Jul 04 and Jun 07 will be the exdate and record date, respectively, for receiving the second 2016 cash dividend of VND800/share (est. 2016 dividend yield of 6.4%) and the first 2017 cash dividend of VND1,000/share. The payments will be made on Jul 28. Besides, VTV sets 2017 business plan of VND4.345trl in revenue (+33.2% YoY) and VND157.2bn in EBT (+117.9% YoY), knowing that in 5M2017, VTV recorded VND1.645trl in revenue and VND75bn in EBT. (Cafef.vn & Vietstock.vn)

**Truong Thanh Furniture Corporation (TTF VN)** – **share issuance and business plan:** TTF plans to seek for shareholder's approval regarding the private placement of 100mn shares at the minimum price of VND10,000/share within 3Q2017. The shares will be subject to 1-year transfer restriction. (*Cafef.vn*)

**BIDV Securities JSC (BSI VN)** – **dividend payment:** Jun 27 and Jun 28 will be the ex-date and record date, respectively, for paying 2016 stock dividend at the ratio of 10,000:307. Accordingly, BSI will issue an addition of 2.77mn shares for this dividend payment, funded by the company's undistributed EAT as of Dec 31, 2016. (*Cafef.vn*)

**AMD GROUP Mining and Investment JSC (AMD VN)** - **shareholder's activity:** Mr. Nguyen Tien Duc has registered to buy 5mn AMD shares via order-matching method from Jun 22 to Jul 21, with intention to raise his stake from 2.7mn shares (4.16%) to 7.7mn shares (11.87%). (*Hsx.vn*)

**Siam Brothers VietNam JSC (SBV VN)** - **dividend payment:** Jun 04 and Jun 05 will be the ex-date and record date, correspondingly, for receiving the 2016 cash dividend of VND2,000/share (est. 2016 dividend yield of 4.5%). The payment will be occurred on Jul 20. (*Hsx.vn*)

**NinhVanBay Travel Real Estate JSC (NVT VN)** - **business activity:** NVT's BoD has approved the plan to restructure the company's debt by transferring assets to raise capital for repayment of bonds issued by NVT on Nov 11, 2014. The total transfer value of around VND245bn would sufficiently cover both principal and interest payments for the bonds. (*Hsx.vn*)

**Royal International Corporation (RIC VN) - 2017 AGM:** RIC will hold its 2017 AGM on Jun 25 at Royal Halong Hotel, Ha Long, Quang Ninh Province. According to AGM documents, the company sets 2017 targets with net revenue of US\$16.9mn and EAT of US\$1.86mn. (*Cafef.vn*)

Construction JSC 47 (C47 VN) - shareholder's activity: From Jun 12 to Jun 15, Mr. Nguyen Duc Vien sold 286,660 C47 shares, thus reducing his ownership to 720,170 shares (4.22%) and no longer being the company's major shareholder. (Vietstock.vn)

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
