# Market commentary

Vietnam Stock Markets had a mixed trading day when both indices headed towards different directions. VN-INDEX was pushed down due to the strong selling forces on large caps from early trading session. Thereafter, the index's slump deepened towards the end of the day despite the late recovery of some blue-chips. Accordingly, SAB suffered 3-day losing streak and finally exerted the most negative impact by alone wiping off 2.02pts of the index. Moreover, other Food & Beverage tickers, including MSN, VNM and BHN, were also among the top laggards, thus further exacerbating the existing bearish sentiment. Furthermore, Health Care and Materials sectors also recorded losses with 0.62% and 0.37% decrease, respectively. On the other hand, only a few pillars managed to buck the market's downtrend and closed in green. Notably, despite sinking in red throughout the morning session, BID experienced the late recovery to become the largest supporter, and thus spreading the optimism to other Banking tickers (such as CTG and MBB). Moreover, FPT and GAS increased as well to positively support the index. At the end, VN-INDEX landed at 803.93pts (-0.24%) with 120 gainers, 139 losers and 81 unchanged. On the contrary, following yesterday's uptrend, HNX-INDEX maintained in green for the whole trading day and finally closed at 105.75pts (+0.54%) with 104 advancers, 75 decliners and 199 unchanged.

Only Consumer Staples (-1.70%), Health Care (-0.62%) and Materials (-0.37%) dropped while IT (+1.49%), Financials (+0.57%) and Industrials (+0.36%) surged. Top index movers included BID (+1.7%), CTG (+1.5%), FPT (+1.5%), GAS (+0.3%) and MBB (+0.9%). On the other hand, top index laggards consisted of SAB (-2.9%), MSN (-4.8%), VNM (-0.6%), HPG (-1.1%) and BHN (-0.9%). Top 3 major block trades included VJC with 2.5mn shares (VND358.7bn), NVL with 1.1mn shares (VND68.1bn) and PVS with 3.68mn shares (VND62.1bn).


Foreigner switched to net sell on both exchanges with total net-selling value of VND24.1bn. They mainly sold VNM (VND85.6bn), MSN (VND26.0bn) and VJC (VND22.1bn) while bought VNM (VND71.6bn), VCB (VND22.4bn) and REE (VND18.8bn).

# **Market News**

Oil held above US\$50 a barrel as a decline in U.S. fuel inventories countered a bigger-thanforecast increase in crude stockpiles. November futures slipped 0.2% in New York after climbing 1.6% on Wednesday. Gasoline supplies dropped a third week to the lowest level since Nov 2015, while distillate stockpiles fell by the biggest amount since 2011, according to government data. Crude inventories expanded by 4.59mn barrels last week, more than the 3.9mn-barrel gain projected in a Bloomberg survey. U.S. oil production also rose for a second week. While crude has rebounded this month, prices have struggled to hold above US\$50 a barrel this year as rising U.S. output stifles supply curbs by the OPEC countries. A committee monitoring compliance with the promised cuts didn't discuss prolonging or deepening them at a Vienna meeting Wednesday, according to a delegate, though Saudi Arabia and others have mooted a possible extension. Meanwhile in the U.S., Secretary of State Rex Tillerson has highlighted flaws in the 2015 international nuclear deal with Iran. (*Bloomberg*)

**U.S. investment in Vietnam is expected to make breakthroughs.** The U.S. ranked ninth out of 122 countries and territories investing in Vietnam as of Sep 2017, with 835 foreign direct investment (FDI) projects worth US\$9.39bn. Economists forecast that U.S. investment in Vietnam will increase in the near future. At end-Aug, Coca-Cola Beverages Vietnam Ltd., which has operated in Vietnam for more than 20 years, announced the completion of an expanded investment package worth US\$300mn in the Southeast Asian nation from 2013-2016, thus raising the company's total capital to more than US\$500mn. Calin Dragan, Regional Director of Coca-Cola in Southeast Asia and the Middle East, said the package will serve as a foundation for Coca-Cola to invest deeper in Vietnam. *(En.vietnamplus.vn)* 

Hanwha Techwin will invest US\$200mn in Vietnam plant. South Korean company has started construction on US\$200mn Hanwha Aero Engines plant in Hoa Lac high-technology zone in Hanoi, according to information from groundbreaking ceremony on Thursday. The plant will focus on manufacturing components for aircraft engines and total investment may increase to US\$260mn. For further information, the first factory within plant complex will start operations by Apr 2018 with other two factories by 2022. (*Bloomberg*)

**Ho Chi Minh City Infrastructure Investment JSC (CII VN) - shareholder's activity:** For restructuring portfolio, VIP Infrastructure Holdings PTE. LTD has registered to sell 11.3mn CII shares via order-matching and put-through methods from Sep 25 to Oct 20. If successful, the fund will reduce its stake from 21,569,840 shares (8.76%) to 10,269,840 shares (4.17%). (*Vietstock.vn*)

**Military Commercial JSB (MBB VN) - ESOP share issuance:** MBB issues 17,127,409 ESOP shares (1% of outstanding shares) from Sep 18 to Oct 03. Such shares will be subject to 2-year transfer restriction starting from the date of issuance. (*Hsx.vn*)

**FLC Group JSC (FLC VN) – 2017 EGM:** Oct 03 and Oct 04 will be the ex-date and record date, respectively, for attending 2017 EGM, which is scheduled within Oct 20 and Oct 30. (*Cafef.vn*)



Minh Phu Seafood JSC (MPC - unlisted) - stock relisting: MPC plans to list 70mn shares on UPCOM at a minimum initial price of VND97,100/share in October, according to Chairman and CEO Le Van Quang. For further information, the company plans to issue 30mn additional shares next year, thus raising registered capital from VND700bn to VND1trl. Besides, MPC plans to sell at least 30% stake to preferably 1-2 foreign investors next year after completing the increase of registered capital with foreign investors being able to acquire over 51% stake. Investors interested in MPC's stake are from Japan, U.S, China, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Hong Kong and EU. (*Bloomberg*)

**Viglacera Corporation (VGC VN)** - shareholders' activities: On Sep 14, VOF Investment Limited, Asia Value Investment Limited, Vietnam Investment Property Holdings Limited, and Vietnam Ventures Limited successfully purchased 960,000 VGC shares, 340,000 VGC shares, 1.9mn VGC shares, and 1.8mn VGC shares, respectively, thus raising the stakes of the group of related foreign investors from 3.83% (16.36mn shares) to 5% (21.36mn shares). **Petro Vietnam Oil Corporation (PV Oil - unlisted) - IPO plan:** In the upcoming IPO in 4Q2017, PV Oil plans to double its offering volume from 10% to 20% of the total share outstanding, equivalent to 210mn shares. The remaining shares (44.7% of the total outstanding shares) will be distributed to some strategic investors, while the government holds 35.1% of its shares. The IPO price will be set at VND13,400/share, according to President and CEO Cao Hoai Duong. For further information, in 1H2017, PV Oil recorded revenue of VND28.3trl (+74% YoY and completing 82% of annual goals) and EBT of VND231bn (+8% YoY and completing 71% of annual goals). **Vietjet Aviation JSC (VJC VN)** - **bonus share issuance**: Sep 22 and Sep 25 will be the ex-date and record date, respectively, for issuing nearly 129mn bonus shares at the ratio of 10:4. Following the issuance, VJC's charter capital will increase from VND3.224trl to nearly VND4.514trl. (*Hsx.vn & Ndh.vn*)

Hai Phong Thermal Power JSC (HND VN - UPCOM) - state divestment: State Capital Investment Corporation (SCIC) plans to sell its entire 9% holding (45mn shares) in HND at the initial price of VND11,300/share on Oct 02, citing SCIC's website. Accordingly, each investor has to register to buy at least 20,000 shares. (*Bloomberg*)

**FECON Corporation (FCN VN) - FOL lifting:** On Sep 19, State Securities Commission (SSC) has approved to lift FCN's FOL from 32% to 75%. For more information, the company's BoD approved to issue 33mn new shares to existing shareholder with the price of VND15,000/share at the ratio of 10:6 in 3Q-4Q2017. The expected proceeds of VND495bn will be used to invest in FCN's projects and supplement the company's working capital (VND46bn). Moreover, FCN will issue 2.5mn ESOP shares at the price of VND10,000/share, in which half of such shares will be subject to 1-year transfer restriction while the remaining will be subject to 2-year transfer restriction. Furthermore, the firm expects to privately offer 25mn shares to strategic investors at the minimum price of VND22,000/share in 4Q2017 to 3Q2018. Such shares will be subject to 1-year transfer restriction. (*Fecon.com.vn & Cafef.vn*)

**Hoa Binh Construction Group JSC (HBC VN) - ESOP share issuance:** HBC's BoD has announced the plan to issue 1mn ESOP shares in 4Q2017 with the price of VND10,000/share. These shares are not subject to any transfer restriction. (*Hsx.vn*)



**KIDO Group Corporation (KDC VN)** – **subsidiary establishment:** Ho Chi Minh City Department of Planning and Investment has approved KDC's establishment of a new wholly-owned subsidiary - Nhat Hao International Company Ltd. - with a charter capital of VND2bn. (*Cafef.vn*)

**Industrial Construction JSC (ICC VN) – dividend payment:** Today is the ex-date for receiving 2016 cash dividend of VND4,000/share. The payment will be made from Sep 29. (*Cafef.vn*)

**Petrovietnam Ca Mau Fertilizer JSC (DCM VN)** – shareholder's activity: DCM's Chief Accountant Dinh Nhu Cuong sold 160,000 shares (0.03%) via order-matching method from Sep 11 to Sep 19, thus reducing his stake in DCM from 216,700 shares (0.04%) to 56,700 shares (0.01%). (*Cafef.vn*)


